RenWeb and FACTS Tuition and Incidental Accounts (www.renweb.com)

RenWeb's ParentsWeb is a private and secure parents' portal that will allow parents to view academic information specific to their children, while protecting their children's information from others. Through ParentsWeb, families can communicate with teachers and other school staff online whenever necessary. You may also view your child's grades, attendance, homework, other useful school information and any other billing information which in prior years was accessed in the FACTS Payment Plan. Going forward, the only way to access FACTS tuition and incidental accounts is by logging into ParentsWeb.

To apply for financial aid, starting in September 2017, each family will need to apply by logging into www.online.factsmgt.com/aid.

RenWeb Home provides access to ParentsWeb from an iPod, iPhone or iPad with the conveniences of an App for an annual subscription of \$4.99 per household. To download the app, go to the Apple App Store or Google Play Store on your device.

Each parent must create an account. For more information and to create an account, please visit www.stcps.org/renweb/.

Classroom assignments are available on RenWeb once you set up your account.

Tuition and Incidental Accounts

All payments for the school year 2017-2018 will be processed through the FACTS Payment Plan. The charges are split into two categories: payment plan and incidental expenses.

- Payment plan charges are automatic payments for the tuition, re-enrollment, and field trips.
- Incidental expenses encompass charges such as tutoring, the music program, St. Col's Clubs, the milk program, the after school, before school, vacation programs and summer program.
- The Before School Program is a drop in program and can be paid in cash (\$5 per day) the day of attendance.
- The invoices for the incidental expenses will be available 10 days before the payment is due. Late payments may prevent your child from attending the programs for which you have enrolled him or her.
- The lunch program payments should be made directly to John Giragosian in cash or check (\$15 minimum). Lunch is \$5.00 per day.

Arrival / Dismissal

Grades 1-8: Arrival and dismissal will occur at the back right door closest to Leicester Street. Arrival time for middle school students is at 7:35AM. Arrival time for grade 1 – 5 students is at 7:45AM. Dismissal time is at 2:50PM in the plaza area by the main back doors.

Early Childhood: Parents may walk their children into the classrooms using the back door **during the first week of school**. Starting on September 11th, parents will drop their children off at the back door or in the car line and students will walk to their classrooms assisted by teachers. The Early Childhood arrival time will be at 8:00AM and the dismissal time will be at 3:00PM.

If you have children who are dismissed at 2:50PM and 3:00PM, the older student may go to the younger students homeroom and pick their sibling up before exiting the building.

Before School Program

The before school program runs every morning beginning at 7AM in the dining hall. The fee is \$5 per student per day and is a drop in program.

After School Program (Pre-K through Grade 4)

The after school program will begin on Wednesday, September 6th. Please visit the school webpage to complete the application.

Grade 5 Homework Club

Grade 5 students may choose to complete their homework in a supervised classroom from 4:00 pm until 5:00 pm. In order to participate, a student must be enrolled in a club from 3:00 pm until 4:00 pm on the day he/she wishes to attend. There is a separate fee for this opportunity of \$10 per day. After School Clubs and Music Program

Milk Program

If you would like your child to receive milk at lunch, please fill out the milk program form on the Back To School Link on the webpage by Friday, September 8th. The cost of milk for the year (Monday through Friday) is \$50 per child and will be deducted from your FACTS account.
