See below for more information on upcoming events and news, including Saint Columbkille's recent official designation as a laboratory school of Boston College's Lynch School of Education.



Saint Columbkille Partnership School Designated a Laboratory School by Boston College's Lynch School of Education



At a reception at Boston College on Monday, March 26, Boston College's Lynch School of Education officially designated Saint Columbkille Partnership School as a laboratory school. The laboratory school designation—the only such arrangement between a university and an elementary school in the city of Boston—will enhance opportunities for teacher training, educational research and professional development at the Pre-K-8 school.
